

University of Derby Post Graduate Course Closure: FAQ

This document is to answer frequently asked student questions about the closure of the MSc in Business and Reward Management and BA (Hons) in Applied Business and Management at the University of Derby.

If I am enrolled onto the BA (Hons) what progression route is available to me?

The CIPP will be running an alternative level 7 postgraduate qualification with Loughborough University. You can enrol onto this MSc Strategic Leadership programme. Alternatively, you may be eligible to enrol onto the Senior Leaders Level 7 apprenticeship, if your organisation is able to draw levy funding.

If I am on year one or two of the MSc at Derby, what does this mean for my progressing years?

If you are currently enrolled onto the MSc, we will be running intakes for you to complete all modules of your qualification so you can graduate.

You will be sent a continuation form once you have completed your current year, so you can enrol onto the next intake.

If I have taken an authorised break from my studies, what are my options?

You should have been contacted and enrolled to complete your studies with the Autumn 2018 intake. Again, if you are enrolled onto year one or two of the MSc you will be able to progress onto the following year(s) and graduate on completion.

If I need to take an authorised break from study, will I be allowed to and how will this affect me?

If you are experiencing extenuating circumstances, you can apply for an authorised break from study through the University of Derby. If your claim is accepted, please be aware that you may be the only student completing the remaining modules on the course.

If I have failed my resubmission attempt, how will my module retake be affected?

In the unfortunate instance that you fail your resubmission attempt, you will be given a module retake opportunity, at a fee. You will be given a module (retake) timetable, to show when your material will be available, tutorial and submission dates.

Please be aware that you may be the only student completing the remaining modules on the course.
